- KNX keypads
- Door Station v1

We are also adding support for conditional time statements. This is a powerful feature that will allow customers to gain higher control when personalizing their home.

# NEW FEATURES

### CONDITIONAL TIME STATEMENTS

Conditional time statements allow customers to specify exactly when a Then executes. Customers can select between certain hours, within a certain time relative to sunrise/sunset, during the day, or during the night.

### SET, RESET, AND TURN OFF TIMERS ON LIGHTS AND FAN SPEED
